Parents & students (both) should each have a financial student aid login name & password (FSA ID) established before attending a workshop. To establish a FSA ID online in 10 minutes go to this website: <https://fsaid.ed.gov/>



To complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA), you will need:

- Your Social Security Number.
- Your Alien Registration Number (if you are not a U.S. citizen).
- Your 2017 federal income tax returns, W-2s, and other records of money earned.

(Note: You may be able to transfer your federal tax return information into your FAFSA using the IRS Data Retrieval Tool.)

- Bank statements and records of investments (if applicable).
- Records of untaxed income (if applicable).
- An FSA ID to sign electronically.

If you are a dependent student, **then you will also need most of the above information for your parent(s).**
